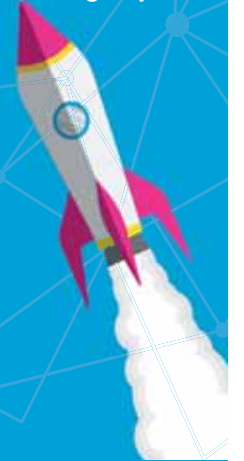

Drury service for pal Keds

Roles have reversed as Danny Kedwell reunites with Andy Drury at Folkestone.

The popular former Gillingham and Ebbsfleet striker has promptly got involved in football once more, having departed his position as manager at Isthmian South East Ashford last month.

He joins in-form Folkestone's backroom staff for their Isthmian Premier play-off push.

The move sees Kedwell work under boss Drury, with Kedwell previously having managed Cray Wanderers - when he had Drury as his assistant - prior to his dismissal in December 2021.

Now the tables have turned, with the pair starting their latest spell together during last weekend's 2-0 victory at hapless Hendon.

"It came as a shock to me leaving Ashford and I didn't really know what I wanted to do," said Kedwell, who worked as player-assistant to Kevin Hake at Chatham before taking on the top job at Homelands.

"I felt a little bit disappointed about it - but that's football - and you've just got to get on with it.

"Dukes rang me up and said 'Do you want to come in and help me?'. I had a little think about it and thought 'Why not?'

"I'd done it at Chatham with Kev and had great success, with some promotions and a play-off final, so it's good to get involved in it again and not as a manager.

"A lot of managers go away for months, but I just wanted to keep involved.

"In the first couple of games I've got to get used to the players and they need to get used to me.

"I said a few words on Saturday, but it's a bit of a hard one to come straight in and put your stamp on things.

"But Dukes was my assistant at Cray Wanderers so, going the

other way around, he knows what he's talking about so that's good."

Kedwell had also taken in Folkestone's 3-0 home win against fifth-placed Horsham last month and has been impressed with what he's seen of the squad so far.

He said: "They're a good bunch, to be honest, and they look like they're all winners.

"They have got a lot of experienced players that have done things a lot higher. You can tell they're a focused team.

"They have their fun on game days but, once it comes down to it with a match, it's down to business."

While things appear on the up for Invicta, they have struggled

to contend with injury issues in their campaign. But Kedwell, now 41, is more than happy to play if required.

He said: "Obviously, I've played a few games this season for Ashford because of the injuries we have had. Dukes watched one of the games and said 'Mate, you have still got it!'

"His team has had a lot of injuries this season, to be fair to him, so he knows I'm there - and that's what I've said to him. I'm at an age where I know the game.

"In the last few years, I've played centre midfield, central defensive midfield, centre-half and up top. I can play anywhere, really, if needed."

A goal in either half from for-

ward Joe Turner and Jack Jebb at Hendon means it's now three straight victories for Folkestone, who have suffered just one defeat in their past eight games.

With a third of the season to go, Kedwell believes they still could secure a play-off berth.

He said: "There's always that one team that sneaks in, isn't there?"

"If they keep performing and they have the belief, I'm sure that they can make it. They just need to keep doing what they're doing."

Their next game will be an important one in their bid for a top-five finish this Saturday.

Invicta host sixth-placed Chichester - three points ahead

of them - this weekend before Tuesday's journey to relegation-threatened Dulwich Hamlet.

"It should be a good game," admitted Kedwell, on the visit of Chichester.

"Obviously they're on a good run, as well, having come up last year. They're still going to be on that high.

"But if we do what we have done in the last two games, I see no reason why we can't beat them. It's going to be a brilliant game.

"We have to look at winning these games because, if we do, it keeps that gap closing between us and the play-off places."

And Kedwell is well-aware just how tough it can be for the

away team to play at Cheriton Road - having been involved in plenty of visiting contingents himself!

"When I've played there before, it's always a hard place to go as an away team," he said.

"When you or your team are playing in front of big crowds - like when I was at Chatham - that does lift you.

"There was a great crowd there for the Horsham game and I'm sure, if we keep putting in the performances, those crowds will get even bigger."

Young Folkestone defender Joel Odeniran came off the substitutes' bench at Hendon, having returned from his latest loan stint at Herne Bay.

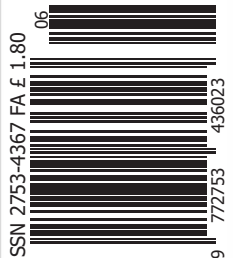
