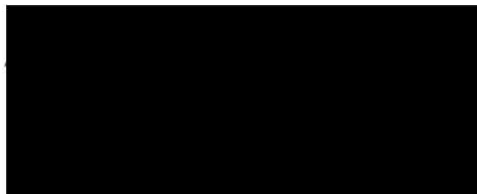
We are dealing with a most persistent applicant! I attach my letter of 14/10/24, subsequent to which his second application was refused.

Erection of a three storey block of six residential flats on land to the rear of Earlscliffe Mews

I see that having his original application refused, this application to build six residential flats on the small piece of land to the rear of Earlscliffe Mews has been resubmitted with scarcely any modification to the original application.

I can only emphasise my strongest possible objection to this application. As stated in my previous letter of 12/08/24 one of my main concerns against building a three storey block of flats on this small piece of land, presently a quiet haven for wild life, is the preservation of a big, beautiful beech tree on the corner of this plot. Also the safeguarding of several other mature trees. Already surrounded by blocks of flats and the 6th Form College this small piece of land needs to be preserved.

The big beech tree must never be felled.
