Dear Sir/madam,

Lympne Parish Council wish to indicate that they object to the planing application 25/1438/FH Erection of a steel framed cladded storage shed and timber fencing to west boundary to footpath:

The reasons for the objections are as follows-

1. The application appears to contradict itself by it will be clad but then appears to indicate it will be a steel framed corrugated storage shed. The application is not clear on its final look
2. The building does not appear to be in keeping with the National Landscape (Previously Conservation Area)

The other concern is that this application indicates that no trees will be removed in order to erect the building however it was raised as a concern that application 25/1533/FH/TCA Works to trees the subject of TPO No 4 of 1995 T01 Ash lift canopy by 2-3m, prune away from utility lines to give 1-2m clearance, remove major deadwood. T09 Monterey Cypress reduce height to approx. 8m. T13 & 14 Sycamore lift canopies to give 4.5-5m ground clearance. T15 Sycamore fell. T16 Cherry fell.

This application states that they wish to remove two trees- This may be a coincidence but members of the Council were concerned that the applications may have been submitted separately in order to pave the way for the erection of the shed.

The Parish Council feel that the potential link between both applications needs to be investigated.
