To whom it may concern

Referring to the recent notice of further development for Willow Court, Enbrook Road I wish to object for the following reasons:

1. The property faces front of our house [REDACTED] and into our garden and any further development onto the top of this structure would invade our privacy due to direct line of sight into our back garden.
2. Additionally, any height added to the existing building will block out our sun during certain times of the year.
3. The additional flats will add to an existing parking issue within Enbrook Road and Saint Paul's Way. Regularly there are cars parked on the double yellow lines and on the corners as well as pavements of Saint Paul's Way due to restricted parking in this area.
4. Additional properties adds to additional drainage and there are often issues with the roads flooding due to drains being backed up.
5. Furthermore the increase in scale alters the established character of the street scene on top of an already overpowering building resulting in a development that appears out of keeping and visually intrusive.

I feel that the proposal conflicts with policy SS1 of the Folkestone and Hythe core strategy which requires development to protect the amenities of existing residents
